# DOCUMENT SETUP


### Info

Commonly required to ensure the action works well

Setup your document before running an action as follows:

### Flatten

Check the layers panel (Menu bar > Windows > Layers) and make sure your photo is flat. This means you have only a single locked layer that has an *italic* label called "*Background*"



If you run a NON-English Photoshop, you may have a different name for this background layer. Please keep it as it is, DO NOT change its name.

If your photo has stack of layers, please go to **Menu Bar**, then select **Layer > Flatten Image**

### RGB

Setup your photo in **RGB** color mode.

To set this: go to **Menu Bar**, then select **Image > Mode > RGB Color**

### 8 Bits

Setup your photo in **8 Bits / Channel**.

To set this: go to **Menu Bar**, then select **Image > Mode > 8 Bits/Channel**

### Use a high resolution photo

Your photo resolution must be setup at 72dpi or higher.

To check this: go to **Menu Bar**, then select **Image > Image Size**
